PRACTICAL COURSE OF IMPLANTOLOGY ON PATIENTS: BASIC AND ADVANCED BUCAREST 2017

Presentation of the course:

In 2016, we expected to organize 3 practical courses on the patient at the Bucharest clinic, but we have had to organize 4 of them for the high number of requests that we received!!!

After this success and the experience we gained, we decided to repeat the same format for 2017, with some interesting news. The PRACTICAL ONLY nature of the course remains unaltered, in which the participant is the true protagonist, directly involved in implantology surgeries under the supervision of qualified and experienced Tutors.

With this purpose, the course is useful for both the beginner who wants to approach the BASIC implant techniques, and the experienced colleague who wants to deepen and extend his/her ADVANCED surgical skills.

To meet the training needs of the advanced participants, they will be able to choose, at the registration (at least 2 months before the course), a clinical module chosen among the following:

"Maxillary Sinuses" Module

"Soft Tissue Management - uncovering" Module

"Post-extractive implants" Module

"Immediate Loading" Module

Thus, it will be possible for the Bucharest clinic to optimally customize the interventions planned with the requests of the participants. It will be possible to perform not only the operations of one macro area, but for example the selection of the "Maxillary Sinuses" Module ensures that the student will perform,

during the days of the course, at least 2 sinus elevations with lateral technique. However, the Tutors and the doctors at the Bucharest clinic will assess if the participant's skills are adequate for the safe performance of the proposed surgery.

On request*, an intensive theoretical course of one day is available (for both Basic and Advanced) before the clinical activity on the patient.

The course will take place at the "Centro Italiano di Implantologia" (Italian Implantology Center), a modern clinic equipped with all the facilities and amenities necessary for the optimal operation.

The participant will be working directly on the patient as first and second operator.

Every surgical session will be preceded by a collegial discussion of clinical cases to be treated with the presentation of the care plan, the 2D / 3D radiological diagnostic and any particular details of the single case.

All work will be performed with the Megagen AnyRidge surgical method, at the forefront of modern implantology.

The course is open to a limited number of participants (6 maximum) to guarantee a high educational effectiveness and the learning of the surgical techniques proposed.

The course lasts three days, full immersion (Thursday, Friday, Saturday) and will be repeated at different times of 2017, subject to availability of the Bucharest clinic and the needs of participants. For dates, please contact the secretariat of Megagen CH.

Course Information:

The course is reserved for a maximum of 6 participants.

Participation fee for the course: € 3,950.00 (VAT included)

The participation fee includes: clinical activity participation as a 1st and 2nd operator of surgical interventions, customized on the training needs of the student

(basic surgery or advanced modules), course materials and disposable instruments, 2 dinners in a typical restaurant, 3 nights in 4-star hotel with bed and breakfast, transfer to / from Bucharest airport, issuance of certificate of participation with the certification of 24 hours of training.

The participation fee does not include: roundtrip flight to Bucharest.

Each participant shall bring 1 implant handpiece, any personal instrumentation (e.g. magnification loupes, burs) and a full uniform for the clinical activity.
